

CURRICULUM

1. We offer core subjects like Mathematics, Science, English, Hindi, Malayalam, GK, Social Science, Moral Science, Art, Physical Education and Skill Subjects for classes VI to X in the academic curriculum of 2026 - 27.
2. We have incorporated Art-Integrated projects in all subjects ,along with Sports, Storytelling and ICT in our pedagogy.
3. Special emphasis is given on digital literacy and multilingualism in teaching, is provided.
4. We maintain continuous tracking of each child's learning outcomes and implement remedial measures whenever required.
5. EK - Bharath - Shresht Bharath activities are conducted along with Yuva Club activities.
6. Various club activities are organised throughout the year, and students actively participate in them.
7. Two Physical Education (P E) periods and one Library period are included in our weekly timetable.
8. We promote experiential learning by providing children with opportunities to explore and discover through hands – on activities.
10. We follow separate examination pattern for Pre-KG, Nursery and Classes I-II.
11. For Classes III to XII (5+3+3+5) , the academic session includes Periodic Tests and Internal Assessments. Annual examinations are conducted for all classes except Classes X and XII, where Revision Tests and Pre-Board Examinations are conducted apart from other exams.
12. Competency- based assessments has been introduced from Class VI .
13. A Holistic Progress Card has been introduced from foundational level with emphasis on multidisciplinary learning outcomes and 360⁰ assessment.
14. As recommended by NCFSE 2023, a multilingual approach has been adopted from the current academic year to strengthen foundational and preparatory stage learning.
15. Outdoor classes are conducted to have experiential learning.
16. We conduct SAFAL examinations to facilitate targeted interventions and improve learning outcomes.
17. We prepare syllabus for each subject and review students' progress during subject council meeting.
18. Lesson plans for all subject are prepared and submitted in advance by the teachers.
19. SQAAF activities are implemented as part of the school's quality initiatives.



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20. Teachers are familiar with NEP 2020 and NCF and maintain their cumulative record regularly.
21. Capacity-building programmes are attended by teachers regularly.
22. Co-Curricular Activities (CCA) are integrated into school timetable for KG to Class V to promote the mental ,emotional and social development of students.
23. We have introduced CT & AI from Classes III to X.
24. Emphasis is given to Vocational Education, as we have introduced Kaushal Bodh for Classes VI to VIII and Kaushal Vikas for Class IX.
25. From Class VI onwards, we have adopted the three-language system, with English as R1, Malayalam as R2, and Hindi as R3, from the academic year 2026-27.
26. In Classes IX, X, and XI, Artificial Intelligence (AI) is offered as a Skill Subject.
